- Supporting the development and upgrading of village facilities, including roads, buildings, and car parks
- Securing grants from various bodies, including:
 - **Parks and Wildlife Service**

Through Gordon's efforts, significant improvements were made—most notably upgrades to the **village dam**, ensuring a reliable, high-quality potable water supply still enjoyed today.
