After transferring to the **Inglewood Lions Club** in **1983**, Rick quickly became an active and influential member. His contributions included:

- **Founder – Youth Encouragement Awards**, supporting young children in local schools and junior sporting groups
- **Regular fundraiser**, selling raffle tickets every Friday at the Maylands Hotel
- **Club President – 1987/88**

These roles showcased Rick's commitment to youth, community engagement, and hands-on service.

District Leadership

Rick's impact extended strongly across the District, where he served in numerous leadership positions, including:

- **District Governor – 1991/92**
- **District Public Relations Chairman – multiple years**
- **Regional Chairman**
- **Member of the 201W1 Cabinet for many years**

His communication skills, promotional energy, and warm personality made him a standout District leader who was well respected across Western Australia.

- **Creator – Walk for Sight**, a major fundraising initiative supporting the Lions Save-Sight Foundation
 - Served as a **Director – Lions Save-Sight Foundation**

Rick's energy, creativity, and constant promotion of Lionism helped raise the profile of Lions throughout the state.
